Dear Mr. Shah:

This is in response to your notification received via electronic mail March 23, 2009 wherein you notified the Department of your facility's intention to operate as a large quantity handler of universal waste at the location listed above. The notification is for the collection and consolidation of Consumer Electronics, Batteries and Mercury-Containing Devices in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26A-7.5.

After reviewing the information contained in your notice, the Department has concluded that the proposed activities are consistent with the large quantity handler provisions. Be advised that the proposed activities are required to meet all of the applicable criteria as specified in N.J.A.C. 7:26A-7.5, 7.6, 7.7, and 8.1 et seq. as applicable (copy enclosed). Any recycling activity which fails to conform to the criteria set out at the above regulations is an illegal solid waste activity and is therefore subject to enforcement action, including monetary penalties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:26A-3.1(b).
